To: All National Federations affiliated with African Boxing and the competent sports authorities of the Republic of Guinea.

Subject: Mandatory Compliance with a Disciplinary Decision – Provisional Suspension

The Secretariat General of African Boxing hereby informs you of the disciplinary decision issued by the Chair of the Ethics and Disciplinary Committee under reference **AfB/DEC/CED/05/2026**.

Pursuant to this decision, **Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé- President of FEGUIBOXE and Mr Ousmane Niang- Secretary General of FEGUIBOXE are subject to a provisional suspension of ninety (90) days, effective immediately**, pending the outcome of ongoing proceedings.

During this period, the concerned **individuals are strictly prohibited** from participating in any boxing-related activities and from exercising any official, administrative, technical, or representative function at any level.

All national federations and relevant authorities **are required to strictly comply with and fully enforce this decision**, and to cooperate in ensuring its effective implementation.

It is expressly recalled that any direct or indirect relationship with a suspended or excluded individual constitutes a breach of the African Boxing Code of Ethics and Discipline. Any individual or entity maintaining such relations may be subject to disciplinary sanctions and judicial proceedings in accordance with applicable regulations.

African Boxing calls on all stakeholders to act responsibly and to strictly adhere to this decision in order to safeguard the integrity of the sport.
