FINAL DECISION

Reference: AfB/DEC/CED/02/06/2026

IN THE MATTER OF:

Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé, Member of Guinea Boxing Federation

I. COMPOSITION OF THE COMMITTEE

This decision is rendered by the Ethics and Disciplinary Committee composed as follows:

- **Mr Emoni Williams**, Member ; acting on behalf of the Chair of the African Boxing Ethics and Disciplinary Committee;
- **Mrs Joel Ngungu**, Member;
- **Mr Lamrana Mohamed**, Member.

II. LEGAL BASIS

This decision is issued pursuant to the provisions of the African Boxing Ethics and Disciplinary Code, in particular Articles 5.4, 5.6 and 16(b), as well as the applicable principles of the World Boxing Code of Conduct.

III. FACTS AND PROCEDURE

Following multiple reported breaches of the African Boxing Ethics and Disciplinary Code and the World Boxing Code of Conduct, disciplinary proceedings were duly initiated against Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé.

The Respondent was formally notified of the charges and invited to submit a written explanation or to appear before the Committee for a hearing scheduled on **16 June 2026**.

Despite proper notification, Mr Baldé failed to submit any written explanation and failed to appear at the scheduled hearing without justification.

Accordingly, the Committee proceeded **in absentia**, in accordance with the applicable disciplinary rules.

IV. FINDINGS

After careful review of the evidence on record and in the absence of any defense or mitigating submissions, the Committee finds that Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé committed serious violations of the African Boxing Ethics and Disciplinary Code and breached the World Boxing Code of Conduct.

His conduct is deemed to have undermined the authority and honour of the President of African Boxing and to have caused reputational harm to the institution. The misconduct is therefore considered serious.

V. DECISION

On the basis of Articles 5.4 and 5.6 of the African Boxing Ethics and Disciplinary Code, and in application of Article 16(b), the Committee hereby decides:

1. To impose a **fine of CHF 20,000 (twenty thousand Swiss Francs)** on Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé;
2. Considering the seriousness of the misconduct, to impose a **four (4) year suspension** from all boxing activities at national, continental, and international levels;

VI. ENFORCEMENT

This decision shall take **immediate effect** upon notification. All member federations and relevant stakeholders are required to ensure its full implementation.

VII. RIGHT OF APPEAL

This decision may be appealed in accordance with the applicable provisions of African Boxing regulations within the prescribed time limits.

VIII. FINAL PROVISIONS

African Boxing reaffirms its commitment to upholding integrity, discipline, and respect within the sport.
