Notification of Disciplinary Decision – Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé

Dear Presidents and Secretaries General,

African Boxing hereby formally notifies all National Federations of the decision rendered by its Ethics and Disciplinary Committee on **22 June 2026**, under reference **AfB/DEC/CED/02/06/2026**, concerning **Mr Alpha Amadou Baldé**, Member of Guinea Boxing Federation.

Following duly conducted disciplinary proceedings, and in accordance with the African Boxing Ethics and Disciplinary Code as well as the applicable principles of the World Boxing Code of Conduct, the Committee has issued its final decision.

The sanctions imposed are as follows:

- A fine of **CHF 20,000 (twenty thousand Swiss Francs)**;
- A **suspension of four (4) years from all boxing-related activities** at national, continental, and international levels.

In accordance with the relevant regulations, this decision **takes immediate effect upon notification** and is binding on all stakeholders within the African Boxing framework.

All National Federations are hereby requested to:

- Ensure the strict and immediate enforcement of this decision within their respective jurisdictions;
- Prevent Mr Baldé from participating in, or being involved in, any boxing activity during the period of suspension;
- Cooperate fully with African Boxing in monitoring and ensuring compliance with this decision.

African Boxing counts on the cooperation and diligence of all its member federations in upholding the principles of integrity, discipline, and respect that govern our sport.
